Norfolk Island offers the visitor a relaxing holiday quite different from any other Pacific Island destination. Discovered by Captain Cook in 1774, Norfolk Island started as a penal colony. After the abandonment of the second settlement, Queen Victoria gifted the island to the descendants of the Bounty mutineers on Pitcairn Island in 1856. From there, Norfolk Island has evolved to what it is today, a delightful and peaceful island offering visitors a relaxed and easy paced holiday away from the hustle and bustle of everyday modern living.
